## CASA Kids

*Making a difference, one family at a time!*

Two precious little girls, age 9 and 4, were removed from their parents and placed with their paternal grandmother. Their parents struggled with substance abuse; the girls were removed after their mother was arrested on drug charges while their father was in rehab. After mom's arrest, she enrolled in rehab.

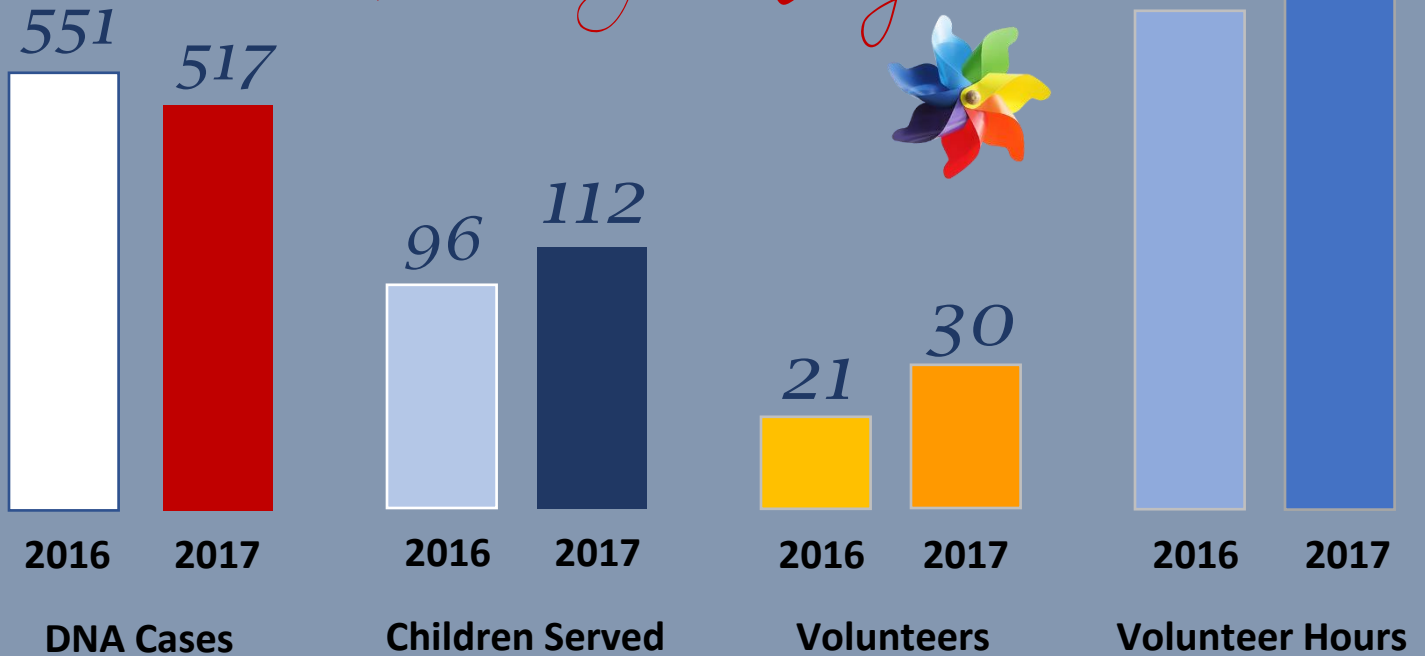
While the girls were happy living with their grandmother, the bond between them and their parents was extremely close, and they wanted to be reunited. Their father eventually got out of his rehab program, but unfortunately failed another drug screen, placing him back in jail. The parents were going to have to make major improvements before our CASA would recommend the kids go back home.

*Thankfully, that's just what they did!*

After dad's second arrest, he enrolled in another rehab, and this time made incredible progress. Mom finished her program as well, and started immediately doing aftercare, going to as many as six AA meetings a week! She also started to volunteer at the rehab facility, helping other women like her in the program. The mother found a job and housing, and the parents started marriage counseling as well. The parents were eventually granted unsupervised visitation and those visits were going very well. Almost two years after the girls were removed from their parents, the girls were able to return home to both parents who were determined to maintain their sobriety!

To quote the CASA worker, "These parents are the perfect example of what determination and faith can do in a family. They are focused on building a happy, healthy life with their children." Today, mom is now employed at the rehab facility and has been sober since January 2016. Dad received his silver chip at his facility, which is a tough thing to do, and has also been sober since January 2016!
